

ORDINANCE NO. 10701

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MUNICIPAL COURT AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2.16 OF THE BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SETTING THE SALARY OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE

WHEREAS, there is a need to adjust the salary of the Municipal Court Judge and to make the process less burdensome in the future;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

2.16.050 Judicial Salaries

- A. The salary for the Municipal Court Judge, effective January 1, 1996, shall be \$35,418.00 per year. For conducting jury trials, the judge shall receive additional pay at the rate of \$60.00 per hour.
- B. The salary for judges pro tem shall be \$50.00 per hour; provided, for conducting jury trials, judges pro tem shall be paid at the rate of \$60.00 per hour.


For years 1997 and following, such salary and levels of compensation shall be set forth and approved in the annual budget, unless the council directs otherwise by separate ordinance.
