

ORDINANCE NO. 1998-05-025

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 1998 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING \$28,515.00 IN ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE STREET DIVISION OF THE STREET FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING A NEW POSITION OF DEPARTMENTAL COMPUTING SPECIALIST II, FROM ENDING UNRESERVED BALANCE.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the workload in the Maintenance Planning Group of the Street Division is causing the need of additional staffing to effectively carry out their assignments; and

WHEREAS, because of the technical nature of the work it is desirable to have the position be in the Information Technology Services Department for supervisory reasons and to provide uniformity in direction; and

WHEREAS, since the position is assigned to work in the Maintenance Planning Group of the Street Division it is appropriate that the Street Fund pay for the position; and

WHEREAS, to maintain a consistent approach the existing Department Computing Specialist I position will also be transferred from the Street Division to the Information Services Technology Department for supervision and will maintain its funding from the Street Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

The sum of \$28,515.00 is hereby appropriated in the Street Division of the Street Fund for the purpose of funding a new position of Department Computing Specialist II. The source of funding will be from:
