**Section 2.** That said vacation is subject to reservation of rights to the City of Bellingham for utility easements within the alley. Any utility to be moved shall be moved at the expense of the petitioner.

<u>Section 3.</u> That no damage will result to any person or persons or to any property by reason of the vacation of said property.

**Section 4.** That the Petitioner's payment for the vacation totaling \$9,500 for the property described in Section 1 has been paid to the City of Bellingham.

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
