AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 1999 BUDGET AND REALLOCATING \$32,400.00 IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE BELLINGHAM BLAST 2000 PROJECT AND RESERVING \$11,413.00 FROM UNUSED SALARY AND BENEFITS FOR THE HUMAN RESOURCES DIRECTOR AND THE DEPUTY ADMINISTRATOR POSITIONS.

WHEREAS, the Bellingham Arts Commission has previously made a presentation to the City Council about the Bellingham Blast 2000 project which will be a year long series of community events to welcome the new millennium; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has endorsed the project and directed the administration to bring forth an ordinance to appropriate the necessary funding for the project; and

WHEREAS, due to an anticipated six month vacancy in the position of the Human Resources Director the Deputy Administrator has assumed those duties as a shared position thus creating excess funds in both positions that can be used for the Bellingham Blast 2000 project: and

WHEREAS, the value of the six month vacancy is greater than the funds required for the Bellingham Blast 2000 project and the remaining \$11,413.00 difference will placed into reserve:

NOW. THEREFORE. THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. The sum of \$32,400.00 is hereby increased in the General Fund for the Bellingham Blast 2000 project for community events to welcome the new millennium.

The sum of \$43,813.00 is hereby reduced in the General Fund to reflect the salary and benefit savings the City is experiencing as a result of the anticipated six month unfilled vacancy in the Human Resources Director position. With the workload being temporarily assigned to the Deputy Administrator a portion of the savings is being experienced in the Executive area.

Section 3. Due to an anticipated six month vacancy in 1999 the following staff reductions are made in Plan E, Section 1:

- A. Level 5 Reduce the position of Human Resources Director by .167 FTE's.
- B. Level 4 Reduce the position of Deputy Administrator by .333 FTE's.

Section 4. The sum of \$11.413.00 is hereby added to estimated ending Restricted Reserve to reflect the difference between the six month position savings and that portion of funding needed for the Bellingham Blast 2000 project.
