AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 1999 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING \$1,468,429.51 IN ADDITIONAL RESOURCES IN VARIOUS FUNDS TO REFLECT THE ADDED EXPENSES AND REIMBURSEMENT RELATING TO THE OLYMPIC PIPELINE DISASTER, FROM UNANTICIPATED REIMBURSEMENT FROM OLYMPIC PIPELINE.

WHEREAS, the Olympic Pipeline disaster emergency could not have been anticipated when the 1999 budget was prepared; and
