

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-07-044.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LAND USE CONTROLS WITHIN THE LAKE WHATCOM WATERSHED AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2000-03-008 WHICH ADOPTED INTERIM LIMITS ON IMPERVIOUS AREA, PERMITTED USES, EARTHWORK.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellingham adopted Ordinance No. 2000-03-008 on April 11, 2000, which placed limits on impervious area, permitted uses, and earthwork within certain areas of the Lake Whatcom Watershed; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance will expire on July 24, 2000, unless it is renewed or replaced by ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has established the Silver Beach Citizen Task Force, a citizens advisory group to study the interim regulations and make recommendations, and

WHEREAS, this task force is in the midst of its work studying the interim regulations and still needs to complete this study and make recommendations to the Planning Commission, and


WHEREAS, while the Citizens Advisory Task Force is completing its study of the issues it is necessary to preserve the status quo,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2000-03-008 is hereby renewed for six months until January 24, 2001. Section 2 of Ordinance 2000-03-008 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. This interim regulation shall expire on January 24, 2001, unless it is sooner repealed or replaced by ordinance. The Planning Commission shall consider amendments to the Land Use Chapter 20 relating to development within the City. The Silver Beach Citizen Task Force shall complete its study of the interim regulations and make recommendations to the City Council.
