

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-10-066

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.33.060 RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING IN BICYCLE LANE AREAS AND PROHIBITING STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING IN DESIGNATED BICYCLE LANES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to protect the health, welfare and safety of bicyclists using designated bicycle lanes and encourage their use; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds that the parking of vehicles upon designated bicycle lanes dangerously diverts bicyclists into automotive traffic and discourages the use of bicycle lanes,

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:**

**Section 1.** Section 11.33.060 of the Bellingham Municipal Code shall be amended to add a new subsection (1)(ak) as follows:

**11.33.060**


(1) Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device, no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle:

(a)-(aj) [UNCHANGED]

(ak) Upon any designated bicycle lane;

(2)-(5) [UNCHANGED]
