

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-02-010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.33.060 RELATING TO STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING UPON DESIGNATED FIRE LANES AND PROHIBITING STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING UPON DESIGNATED FIRE LANES.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to protect the health, welfare and safety of its citizens from fires and other emergencies requiring the use of fire lanes by emergency vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that the parking of vehicles upon designated fire lanes endangers its citizens by interfering with emergency vehicles' access,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 11.33.060 of the Bellingham Municipal Code shall be amended to add a new subsection (1)(a) as follows:

11.33.060


(1) Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device, no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle:

(a)-(ak) [UNCHANGED]

(a) Upon any designated fire lane on public or private property.

(2)-(5) [UNCHANGED].


