

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-07-056

AN ORDINANCE CREATING BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.15.500 AND SPECIFYING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF CHAPTER 11.15 OF THE BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the City has, pursuant to its police powers, prohibited certain conduct in addition to that prohibited by the Model Traffic Code, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to clearly state the penalty for violations of the provisions of Chapter 11.15 of the Bellingham Municipal Code and be consistent with state law, and

WHEREAS, the Washington Supreme Court has recently changed the schedule for infractions,


THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A new section of the Bellingham Municipal Code, 11.15.500, is hereby enacted as follows:

Penalty

Any person violating any section of this chapter shall be guilty of having committed an infraction and shall be punished by a penalty equal to the amount set forth in Infraction Rules for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction rule 6.2 for unlisted infractions, including statutory assessments, unless otherwise specified by ordinance.
