

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-04-028

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM, WASHINGTON
AMENDING BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.33.185.**

WHEREAS, the City of Bellingham has found the need to amend Bellingham Municipal Code 11.33 in order to eliminate a gap in enforcement of the City's prohibition on parking in residential yards; and

WHEREAS, the City has a substantial interest in amending said provision in order to enhance the quality of life of residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: BMC 11.33.185 is hereby amended as follows:

11.33.185 Parking Within Residential Yards Prohibited


No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle within the area designated as a Minimum Front Yard, or Side Yard on a flanking street, as defined in Bellingham Municipal Code Section 20.30.040(F), within a residentially zoned area, when the required minimum front or side yard abuts any street, road, sidewalk or curb. Parking shall be permitted in and upon designated driveways as provided in this section. The designated driveway is defined as the surfaced roadway leading from the street to the garage, covered parking area, or other permitted off street parking area.




