

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-09-066

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 2004 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING \$50,000.00 IN ADDITIONAL RESOURCES IN THE GENERAL FUND FROM THE PROCEEDS OF UNEXPECTED ONE-TIME REVENUE TO FUND TRANSITIONAL HOUSING AND SUPPORT SERVICES AT DOROTHY PLACE.

WHEREAS, the Opportunity Council is the largest private non-profit social service provider in Bellingham and has been operating for 39 years; and,

WHEREAS, the funding will support transitional housing and support services at Dorothy Place, a facility for women and children survivors of domestic violence; and,

WHEREAS, the City has received one-time revenue as the result of a recent franchise fee and cable tax audit that could be used to meet this need.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

The sum of \$50,000.00 is hereby appropriated in the General Fund to fund a one-time contribution to the Opportunity Council. The source of funding will be from:


