

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-10-071

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTIONS 15.08.250, 15.12.175, 15.12.180, 15.12.190 AND 15.20.030 OF THE BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE TO MODIFY WATER AND SEWER UTILITY RATES AND CHARGES.

WHEREAS the City of Bellingham (the "City") Municipal Code currently sets forth water and sewer rates and charges; and,

WHEREAS the water and sewer rates and charges should be revised to reflect increasing operating expenses and equity among and within customer classifications; and,

WHEREAS the revised rates included in this Ordinance are based upon the actual cost of providing water and sewer service and thus are in the best interests of the City of Bellingham and its utility customers and residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: Bellingham Municipal Code Section 15.08.240 is hereby amended as follows:

15.08.240 - Computation Of Use Rates

Use rates for water service and consumption are determined as follows:

- A. Single family unmetered water services and unmetered duplex water services shall be charged a monthly rate for each month of service or portion thereof.
- B. Single family metered water services including metered duplexes shall be charged a fixed rate based on meter size and a volume rate per hundred cubic feet of water used.
- C. Contract sales of water for reuse shall be as covered by agreement between the city and the water district or association. Rates for reuse shall be covered by subsection B of this section unless specifically modified by the agreement in recognition of substantial differences in service provided by the city.
- D. Non-single family water services including multiple dwelling units, commercial, and institutional, shall be charged a fixed rate based on meter size and a volume rate per hundred cubic feet of water used.
- E. Irrigation water services shall be charged a fixed rate based on meter size and a volume rate per hundred cubic feet of water used.
- F. **[UNCHANGED]**
- G. Funds received for the connection charges covered under section 15.08.230.A(2) & 15.08.230.A(3) shall be credited to the cumulative water reserve fund. All system

development charges covered under 15.08.250 shall be credited to the cumulative water capital reserve fund.

Section 2: Bellingham Municipal Code Section 15.12.175 is hereby amended as follows:

15.12.175 – Sewer System Development Demand-Charge Imposed.

A. The system development charges for new sewer service or exchange services shall be determined by the size of the water service serving the premises and shall be imposed as follows:

For meter sizes greater than 4", the system development charge may be adjusted if it can be shown through an engineering analysis that the actual meter flow equivalents are less than shown above.

For industrial connections, the system development charge shall equal the anticipated peak daily flow divided by 405, times \$2,750.

B. [UNCHANGED]

Section 4: Bellingham Municipal Code Section 15.12.180 is hereby amended as follows:

15.12.180 - Flat-Rate Services - Sewer Use Rates.

A. Flat-rate services are charged a monthly rate for each month or portion of a month in which service is received. The flat rate applies to any unmetered or metered single family dwelling-unit that is connected to the city's sewer system; and to any dwelling unit that is connected to the city's water system, and abuts a city right-of-way or utility easement within the corporate limits of the city containing a sewer main, thereby being capable of receiving sewer service.

B. The use rate for flat-rate service is \$24.25 per month in 2005 for single-family dwellings. The use rate will remain at \$24.25 until December 31, 2009. Beginning on January 01, 2010 the use rate will be \$24.98 until December 31, 2010. Thereafter, the rate shall be adjusted annually by the inflationary factor tied to the Seattle Consumer Price Index (CPI).

C. The use rate for unmetered duplexes is \$48.50 per month in 2005. The use rate will remain at \$48.50 until December 31, 2009. Beginning on January 01, 2010 the use rate will be \$49.96 until December 31, 2010. The foregoing use rates will remain effective until December 31, 2010. Thereafter, beginning on January 1, 2011, the rates may be adjusted annually by the City Council and reflect, at a minimum, an inflationary factor tied to the Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton index.

Section 5: Bellingham Municipal Code Section 15.12.190 is hereby amended as follows:

15.12.190 - Metered Services – Sewer Use Rates.

For all metered services, including multiple dwelling units, commercial services, institutional and those industrial users not subject to Chapter 15.20 of this title, the use rate is based on the volume of water used on the premises, as follows:

A. In 2005, \$24.25 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used plus \$2.54 for each additional one hundred cubic feet of water, or fraction thereof, used. These use rates will remain in effect until December 31, 2007. Thereafter, the rate shall be the following:

(1) In 2008, Multiple Dwelling Units, including metered duplexes, shall have a use rate of \$23.17 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used plus \$2.90 for each additional one hundred cubic feet of water, or fraction thereof, used.

(2) In 2009, Multiple Dwelling Units, including metered duplexes, shall have a use rate of \$24.53 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used plus \$3.07 for each additional one hundred cubic feet of water, or fraction thereof, used.

(3) In 2010, Multiple Dwelling Units, including metered duplexes, shall have a use rate of \$25.27 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used plus \$3.16 for each additional one hundred cubic feet of water, or fraction thereof, used.

(4) In 2008, Commercial, Institutional and Industrial (medium strength) shall have a use rate of \$22.33 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used plus \$2.79 for each additional one hundred cubic feet of water, or fraction thereof, used.

(5) In 2009, Commercial, Institutional and Industrial (medium strength) shall have a use rate of \$23.64 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used plus \$2.96 for each additional one hundred cubic feet of water, or fraction thereof, used.

(6) In 2010, Commercial, Institutional and Industrial (medium strength) shall have a use rate of \$24.35 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used plus \$3.04 for each additional one hundred cubic feet of water, or fraction thereof, used.

B. These foregoing use rates will remain effective until December 31, 2010. Thereafter, beginning on January 1, 2011, the rates may be adjusted annually by the City Council and reflect, at a minimum, an inflationary factor tied to the Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton index.

Section 6: Bellingham Municipal Code Section 15.20.030 is hereby amended as follows:

15.20.030 - Applicability--Rates And Charges.

A. The rates and charges set out in this section shall apply to all system users who meet the criteria described in Section 15.20.020, but who are not required to execute a utility service contract as described in Section 15.20.070.

B. On January 01, 2005 the following rates and charges are in effect until December 31, 2007.

- (2) A Volume Charge is set at \$2.21 for each hundred cubic feet of water used over the first eight hundred cubic feet.
- (3) An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.17 per pound of "Biochemical Oxygen Demand" (abbreviated as BOD.)
- (4) An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.15 per pound of "Total Suspended Solids" (abbreviated as TSS.)

C. On January 01, 2008 the following rates and charges are in effect until December 31, 2008.

1. Minimum Fixed Charge for each account is \$17.97 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used.
2. A Volume Charge is set at \$2.25 for each hundred cubic feet of water used over the first eight hundred cubic feet.
3. An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.17 per pound of "Biochemical Oxygen Demand" (abbreviated as BOD.)
4. An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.15 per pound of "Total Suspended Solids" (abbreviated as TSS.)

D. On January 01, 2009 the following rates and charges are in effect until December 31, 2009.

1. Minimum Fixed Charge for each account is \$19.03 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used.
2. A Volume Charge is set at \$2.38 for each hundred cubic feet of water used over the first eight hundred cubic feet.
3. An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.18 per pound of "Biochemical Oxygen Demand" (abbreviated as BOD.)
4. An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.16 per pound of "Total Suspended Solids" (abbreviated as TSS.)

D. On January 01, 2010 the following rates and charges are in effect until December 31, 2010.

1. Minimum Fixed Charge for each account is \$19.60 for the first eight hundred cubic feet of water used.

2. A Volume Charge is set at \$2.45 for each hundred cubic feet of water used over the first eight hundred cubic feet.
3. An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.19 per pound of "Biochemical Oxygen Demand" (abbreviated as BOD.)
4. An Industrial High-Strength Surcharge is set at \$0.16 per pound of "Total Suspended Solids" (abbreviated as TSS.)


E. The foregoing use rates will remain effective until December 31, 2010. Thereafter, beginning on January 1, 2011, the rates may be adjusted annually by the City Council and reflect, at a minimum, an inflationary factor tied to the Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton index.

Section 7: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect on January 01, 2005.
