

**ORDINANCE NO. 2006-12-112**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 2006 BUDGET APPROPRIATING \$20,000 IN ADDITIONAL RESOURCES IN THE MEDIC ONE FUND FROM ENDING RESERVES TO BE USED FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW AMBULANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Whatcom Medic One has experienced significant mechanical problems with one of their ambulances and,

**WHEREAS**, the most recent ambulance re-chassis has resulted in repeated mechanical problems and,

**WHEREAS**, taking an additional ambulance out of service to send out for re-chassis would have negative impacts on response times,

**WHEREAS**, a modest additional increase of \$20,000 in unbudgeted funds is needed to purchase a new ambulance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:**

The sum of \$20,000 is hereby appropriated in the Medic One Fund for the purpose of purchasing a new ambulance. Funding will be credited from:




