

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-06-046

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 2007 BUDGET APPROPRIATING \$12,315.32 IN ADDITIONAL RESOURCES IN THE GENERAL FUND TO ACCOUNT FOR RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF GRANT FUNDS ON REPLACEMENT OF OUTDATED RADAR UNITS AND PURCHASE OF RAIN GEAR FOR MOTORCYCLE OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, The Washington State Traffic Safety Commission has given the City of Bellingham a grant to be used to purchase rain gear for motorcycle officers and to replace outdated radar units which will be used to enhance traffic safety in school zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:


