ORDINANCE NO. 2009-08-050

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2009 BUDGET INCREASING THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION TO THE UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION FUND AND ESTIMATED ENDING UNDESIGNATED RESERVES BY \$520,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Association of Washington Cities announced an employer's "Premium Holiday", for the last eight months of 2009 for employee Life Insurance, saving the City approximately \$120,000.00, and;

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislators reduced the employer's contribution to the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) and Law Enforcement Officer and Firefighter Retirement System Plan 2 (LEOFF-2) for the last six months of 2009, saving the City approximately \$400,000.00, and;

WHEREAS, the City realizes that both of these one-time savings are not sustainable and desires to increase the reserves of the Unemployment Compensation Fund in anticipation of future payments due to the economic downturn, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Contributions from the employer are hereby increased by the sum of \$520,000.00. The source of funds will be credited from:
