

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-09-056

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 2010 BUDGET APPROPRIATING \$235,720.19 FROM ESTIMATED ENDING UNDESIGNATED RESERVES IN THE FLEET FUND TO PURCHASE NINE CROWN VICTORIA POLICE PATROL VEHICLES AHEAD OF SCHEDULED REPLACEMENT DATES IN 2011 AND 2012.

WHEREAS, Ford Motor Company has indicated that it will stop production of the Crown Victoria Police Patrol Vehicle in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington contract with Ford Motor Company for Police Crown Victoria Police Patrol Vehicles expires on September 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to maintain a fleet utilizing a consistent proven vehicle; and

WHEREAS, changing to a new vehicle will require modifications and changes to install light bars, radio consoles, computer mounts, and trunk packages; and

WHEREAS, sufficient reserves exist in the Estimated Ending Undesignated Fleet Fund for making this purchase ahead of schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

The sum of \$235,720.19 is hereby appropriated in the Fleet Fund. The source of funds will be credited from:
