## ORDINANCE NO. 2017-06-017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2017/2018 ADOPTED BUDGET RECOGNIZING \$9,868,874 PROPERTY TAX REVENUES IN THE GREENWAYS FUND, APPROPRIATING A PORTION OF THAT FOR CAPITAL AND MAINTENANCE EXPENDITURES IN THE PARKS DEPARTMENT, AND INCREASING ENDING RESERVES IN THE GREENWAYS FUND.

WHEREAS, voter passage of the Greenways levy was not certified at the time the budget was adopted so the revenue was not included in the 2017-2018 Adopted Budget; and

WHEREAS, Greenways IV property tax levy passed by Bellingham residents on November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City adopted an updated Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan as part of the update to the Comprehensive Plan in November of 2016 establishing updated priorities for park and open space acquisition, development and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, , the use of the Greenways IV funding provided guidelines to allow approximately 25% of the proceeds for maintenance and operations and capital replacement needs of park properties and facilities; and

WHEREAS, there is a backlog of significant capital maintenance projects that have been prioritized by staff based on safety, level of use, and importance within the park system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Greenways Advisory Committee is in the process of developing an updated strategic plan to address future property acquisition and development priorities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks Department will focus initial staff time and levy resources towards addressing the priority capital maintenance projects while the effort to update the strategic plan occurs, as well as complete already funded development projects.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Effective July 1, 2017 a two-year, limited term Project Manager, Plan S, is hereby created in the Parks Department. This will add 1.0 FTE in 2018 and 0.5 FTE in 2017 and 2019.

The source of funds for staffing, project and maintenance costs will be credited from:
