### **RESOLUTION NO. 2023-29**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE RELINQUISHMENT OF A PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT LOCATED WITHIN VACATED MCKENZIE STREET THAT IS SURPLUS TO THE CITY'S NEEDS

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bellingham, under Ordinance No. 6995, vacated a portion of McKenzie Street between 12<sup>th</sup> Street and 13<sup>th</sup> Street ("**Vacated Street**"), subject to the City's retention of an easement for future utilities within the Vacated Street as authorized by RCW 35.79.030 ("Retained Utility Easement"); and

**WHEREAS**, Peoples Bank (the "Property Owner") owns certain real property commonly known as 1315 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Bellingham, Washington, legally described in Exhibit A hereto (the "Subject Property"), a portion of which is encumbered by the City's Retained Utility Easement; and

**WHEREAS**, the portion of the Subject Property that is encumbered by the Retained Utility Easement is legally described in <u>Exhibit B</u> hereto and depicted in <u>Exhibit C</u> hereto (the "Relinquishment Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Property Owner has asked the City to relinquish that portion of the Retained Utility Easement that encumbers the Relinquishment Area in order to facilitate private development and construction on the Subject Property; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 35.94.040 authorizes cities to lease, sell or convey property originally acquired for utility purposes if, following a public hearing, the legislative authority for the city determines by resolution that such property is surplus to the city's needs and is not needed for providing continued public utility service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Public Works Department has determined that the portion of the Retained Utility Easement that encumbers the Relinquishment Area is not needed for public utility service and is, therefore, surplus; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council held a public hearing on December 11, 2023 to accept public comment upon and consider the proposed relinquishment.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM THAT:

- 1. The City has no present or foreseeable need to use that portion of the Retained Utility Easement that encumbers the Relinquishment Area for public utilities.
- The Mayor is authorized to execute all documents necessary to relinquish that portion of the Retained Utility Easement that encumbers the Relinquishment Area.
